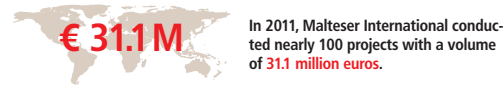

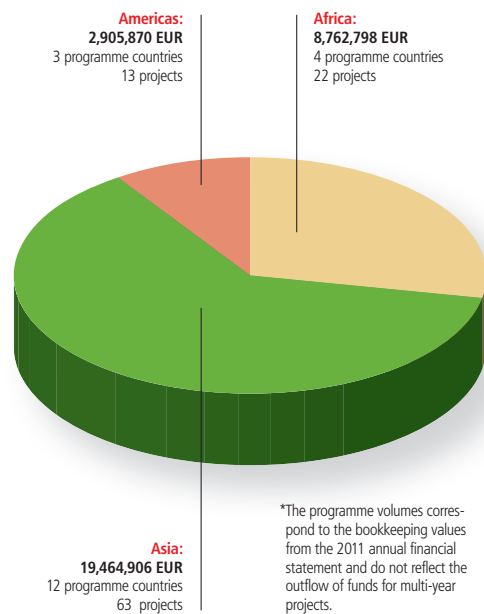

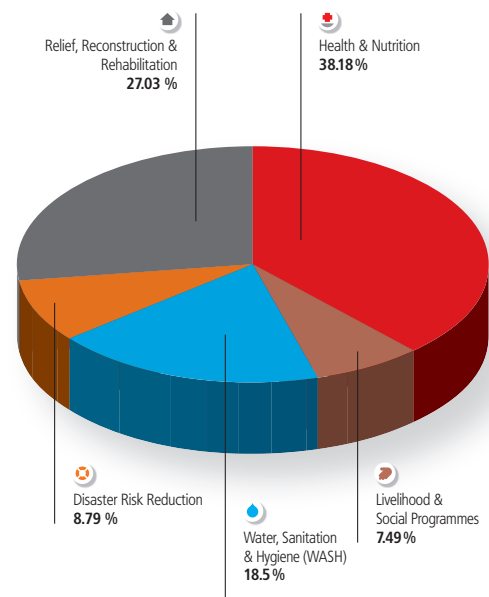

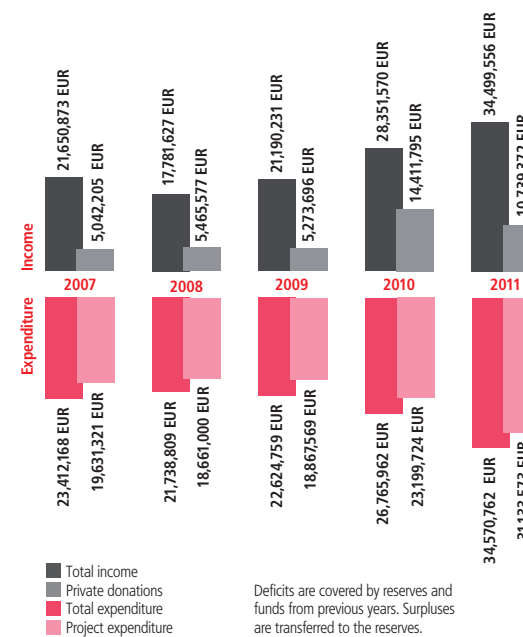
## Programme expenditure by region 2011\*

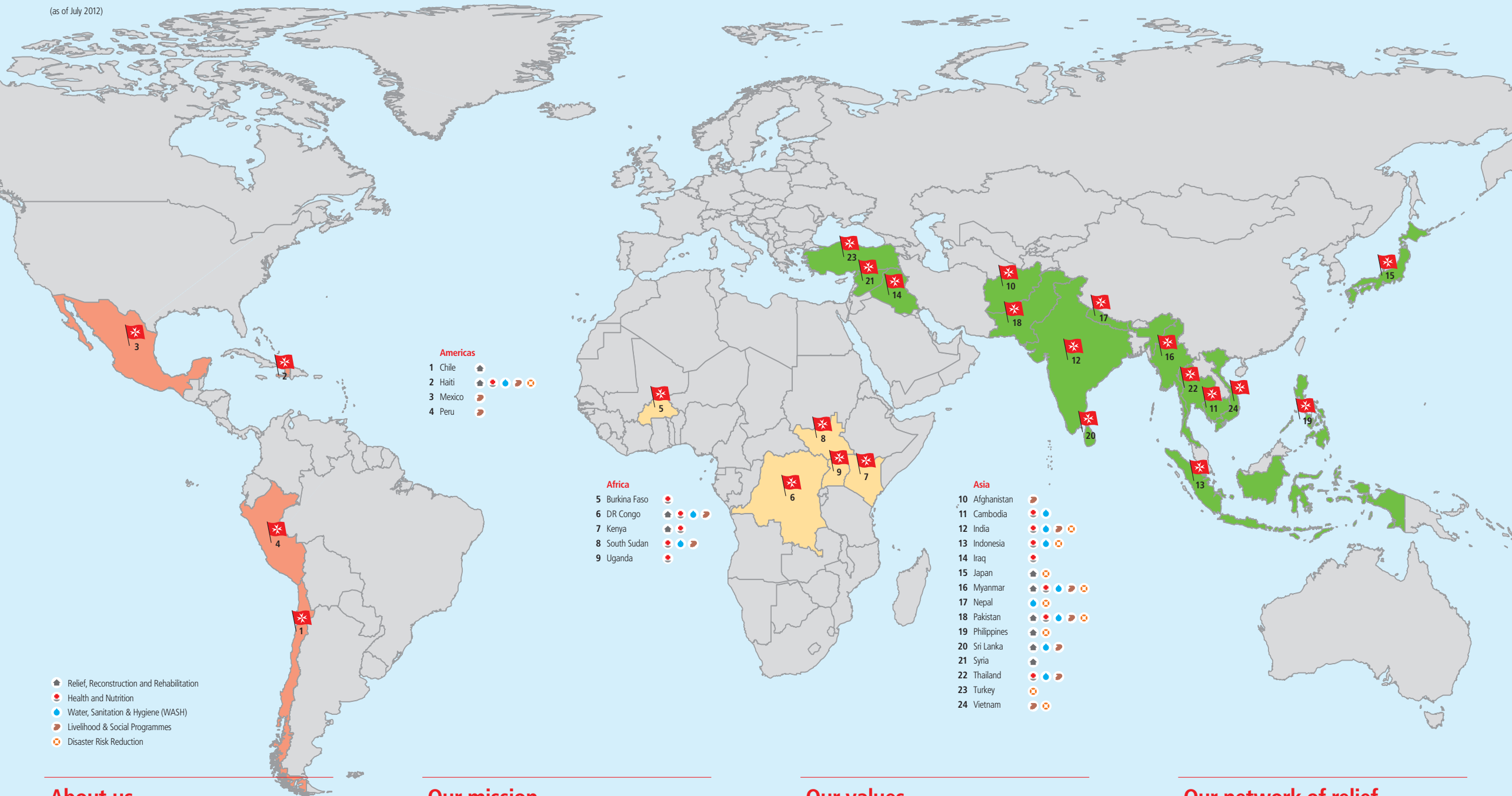
